

HOW TO CATCH THE WAVE IN 6 EASY STEPS



1 CALL FOR INFORMATION

It's easy to learn:

- which bus to take
- where and when to catch the bus
- the exact fare needed
- when you'll arrive at your destination

2 IF YOU'RE USING A TIMETABLE

Follow these quick steps to find out where and when to catch your bus:

1. Make sure you have the current timetable. Look for the route number, color, or the destination served by the route.

2. Read across the top of the route schedule to find the bus stop names where you want to get on the bus and where you want to get off the bus.

3. Read down the column under where you want to get off the bus until you find the time you want to arrive. Next, move left back across the row to the time shown in the column under where you want to get on the bus. This time is the time when you need to be at the bus stop to start your trip. Try to be a few minutes early and plan your return trip by repeating these steps

3 FINDING YOUR BUS STOP

Just look for the bus stop signs nearest where you want to get on the bus.

If you would like to know the exact location of your stop, call us at 503-815-8283, our friendly staff will help you find the stop located closest to you.



4 KNOWING WHICH BUS IS YOURS

You can tell where the bus is going by the sign on the front of the bus above the windshield. The sign tells what the route number and the final destination of the bus is.

As the bus approaches, step closer to the curb and wave to let the driver know you want to get on. If you're not sure it's the right bus, ask the driver.

ROUTE DESTINATION

It will tell you the service provided, major areas being served, or final destination of the route.



5 FARES AND PAYING ON THE BUS

Tickets and passes are available from the bus driver or from Tillamook County Transportation District offices at 3600 3rd Street, Suite A, Tillamook, OR 97141

Paying on the bus:

Cash and Tickets: Show driver before placing exact fare or ticket in the fare box when you get on the bus.

Passes: Show the driver your pass and have a seat.

Fare Schedule: Located on far right side of this map. Shows exact fare needed according to your destination and needs.



6 GETTING OFF THE BUS

About a block before your stop, let the bus driver know you want to get off. When you get off the bus, check to make sure you have all your stuff. For your safety, step away from the bus and wait until the bus pulls away before crossing the street, so you can see traffic clearly.
